"Lining the streets" with flags requires two things: flags and manpower. If you look closely at any of the flags you'll see that each is embroidered with a name. We encourage you to purchase your own flag (see inside panel for flag order form). We depend on your generosity and patriotism. Manpower takes the obvious form of putting up and taking down the flags. There are also other jobs such as drilling and cleaning flag holes in the spring, washing flags, ect. This is provided by the Committee and the various organizations and individuals who wish to help in this effort.

Additional Display

Any individual or business outside the current display area may purchase a flag through our committee.

We will display, store & care for the flag.

It is our policy that we will not "spot place" flags in a particular location for displays. As our program grows so does the number of flags in it.

The full display will expand from the existing streets targeted as our flag collection (& TOWN) expands!

Targeted Display Routes

The Committee plans to display U.S.A. flags at 12' to 20' intervals along both sides of:

- 5th & 6th Street from the North island to the South island
- Highland from Parkway to 19th St
- Glacier from Parkway St to 15th St
- **Evergreen from Parkway to 9th St

** New flags added to the display will be flown on Evergreen, at City Hall, for their first time out.
